b: New England regional tuition of \$12,600 per year is offered for residents of MA, NH, VT, and ME.

c: Mandatory fees include a one-time laptop fee and clinical lab fee.

d: Includes a \$1,900 tablet computer fee upon entry into the program.

e: A graduate tuition per credit hour of \$1,365 for a four credits of microbiology/immunology course taught outside the UF COP must be added to the \$11,346 tuition and \$1,792 mandatory fees to yield a total of \$14,503 for the first professional year.

f: Nonresident tuition includes mandatory fees.
